I have two more questions:

* How close can an expert come to SKB without being questioned?

(Melvyn Gascoyne has been a consultant of SKB during the past 4 years.

He reviewed a couple of part-reports for the safety report that NEA now will review.

He has published articles financed by SKB, in one there is stated "Thus, the 'Swedish Model', can hopefully be seen as an example to the geoscientific community as a suggested 'how to do it' for nuclear waste disposal in a geological environment"

SKB published a report he wrote. The work initially had American money, but was not going to be published. SKB payed for the printing, to get a verification of Swedish software used elsewhere.)

* The Swedish NGO Office for Nuclear Waste Review (MKG) considers Simcha Stroes-Gascoyne unsuitable. They are also pointing at her work with Frasier King, another SKB consultant. "It is obvious that the connections the Canadian member has to supporters of the KBS method is too large for her to be part of an independent review of the application". What do you have to say to them?
